2010 Summer Traveling Soccer Evaluation and Team Enrollment Process Description

Centennial SC's registration system uses a 'evaluation-bid-acceptance' method for allocating players to teams. The software available through the registration system manages this process, and allows for automatic notification of status when events change, and online acceptance of team placement. The following steps describe the process, which is illustrated in the flowchart below also.

[1] Player registers online for the Summer 2010 Travel program. There is a non-refundable \$25 evaluation fee. A confirmation email will be generated and sent to the registration address with details. If a player intends to play up, they must register for—and attend—the evaluations for both their desired and natural age groups. You must contact the registrar to be able to register outside a player's natural age group. **[2]** Attend evaluations for the age group for which you are registered. **[3]** If you are selected for a team, you will receive a bid for that team slot along with a player commitment form via email. If you are not selected, you will receive notification via email. **[4]** If you receive a bid, log in to the registration system and accept the bid and commitment online for team placement, and pay the \$125 non-refundable deposit. You have 48 hours from receipt of the bid to accept. **[5]** If a player chooses not to accept the team bid within the allotted time, the slot that was reserved for them will be freed to go to other players.
